



Kids Create Volunteers work exclusively in our Kids Create program. They have an interest in art and crafts from around the world and a genuine desire to share the enjoyment of art and art making with the community. Kids Create volunteers work with youth and special interest groups (such as scouts and clubs) leading hands-on art making activities at The Mini-Time Machine Museum and occasionally at venues away from the Museum.

Kids Create Volunteers are flexible, imaginative and creative individuals who enjoy working with youth. Miniature enthusiasts, artists and crafters make ideal candidates for this program.

Program Outline:

Kids Create is a monthly family program to engage youth with miniatures from the perspective of the creator through the experience of hands-on art making. Taking inspiration from miniatures in the collection, museum staff design a hands-on art or craft experience for children with an adult partner.

Training:

- Monthly training sessions- Training sessions provide volunteers with the monthly lesson plan and the skills to create a sample project.
- Volunteers learn about the miniature(s) that inspired the hands-on art experience.

Responsibilities:

- Attend monthly training session
- Volunteers help prepare materials, set-up and break-down the classroom.
- Volunteers participate in a minimum of one hands-on art making session or off-site event every month.

Benefits:

- Exclusive lecture presentations about miniatures in the collection
- 10% discount on museum shop purchases, classes and workshops
- 4 free passes annually after 20 hours of service
- Annual recognition luncheon

The Mini-Time Machine Museum of Miniatures is located in central Tucson on the north side of Camp Lowell Dr. just west of Swan Rd.
